10 And God said to him, "Your name is Jacob; no longer shall your name be called Jacob, but Israel shall be your name." So he called his name Israel. Genesis 35:10 (ESV)

Jacob means heel or footprint. Can you imagine being called heel as you grew up. "Come over here, heel". "Heel, go and fetch water". Jacob was the younger twin brother of Esau. The Lord changes Jacob's name to Israel, which means to strive, contend, to rule, to fight. So heel changed to one who fights or rules or contends. What a name change!

The Lord changes Jacob name later in his life. The reader is focused on the patriarch's transformation, from "Jacob" the heel and trickster to "Israel" the one blessed of God. Here the context highlights the national and royal importance of the name, shown by the new character of the promises in Genesis 35:11 and the first formal listing of his twelve tribal descendants (Genesis 35:23–26).
