#### Pastor Mark's Blog – April 7<sup>th</sup>

And you became imitators of us and of the  
Lord, for you received the word in much  
affliction, with the joy of the Holy Spirit.

1 Thessalonians 1:6 (ESV)

I was struck reading this Friday  
morning that Paul uses the term imitators,  
referring to himself and to the Lord in the  
same sentence. At first that can come over  
as a very bold sentence. Imitators can also  
be translated follower. In 1 Corinthians 11:1  
Paul writes “Be imitators of me, as I am of  
Christ”. I think that is the real meaning  
here, following and imitating Christ.

Today we start a 10-part series on  
the Beatitudes. Each Beatitude starts with  
the word, Blessed. The word “blessed”  
refers to those who are, or will be, happy,  
fortunate, or “to be congratulated” because  
of God’s response to their belief, behavior  
or situation. The Beatitudes have an  
“Already and Not Yet” promise for our lives.  
It can also be said that the Beatitudes show  
the conversion process of a person to  
imitating and following Christ.
