Did you notice those words above, "<u>abounding</u> in it with <u>Thanksgiving</u>"? Thanksgiving and gratitude have positive implications for life today.

In a recent study done amongst 300 college students, it was shown that gratitude helps to unshackle us from toxic emotions. People writing thankfully were more likely to use words about positive emotions, to use inclusive pronouns like we, and use fewer negative emotional descriptors. Such persons reported overall better lasting mental health. It was also shown that gratitude's benefits grow over time.

For those established in and walking in the faith, Paul challenges us to abound in Thanksgivings.
