"The first book of Psalms includes Psalms 1 through Psalms 41. All of them except 1, 2, 10 and 33 have David listed as the author. It may well be that David is also the author of those Psalms, but strictly speaking we have to say the author is anonymous.

The first two Psalms summarise the two pillars of Israel's existence at the time, the Torah (Psalm 1) and the Messiah (Psalm 2). It is very sad that bible history shows us that Israel rejected both the Torah and ultimately the Messiah. Jesus was the one person in whom the Torah and the Messiah meet perfectly together. We are very fortunate that as we read the Psalms, we feel we are reading about a person's faith forged through their life experiences. But we are also made to think about somebody else, someone foreshadowed in the Psalms, our living Torah and our living Messiah, the person of Jesus Christ.
